Dear Parents,

Your children have been wonderful this term, working hard and coping with lots of changes due to these unusual circumstances. It was lovely to see their faces on Friday when they saw themselves feature on 'Remotely Christmas' and also watched Santa's mischievous elves playing outside our school! They were thrilled with the presents that the elves left them! Last week, Nursery, Reception and Year 1 loved the The Littlest Elf performance and today Finches and Seabirds will enjoy watching their Sleeping Beauty pantomime.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank the Friends Committee for all their fundraising efforts this term. They have raised an amazing amount of money and we are very grateful to yourselves and members of the community for supporting these activities.

Public Health England and the DfE expect schools to continue to track and trace the contacts of any positive Covid-19 school cases for a period of six days following the final day in school. I would be grateful, therefore, if you would continue to inform me, via Class Dojo or Tapestry, if your child tests positive during this period. I can then respond accordingly. You only need to get in touch with me if your child develops symptoms within 48 hours of being in school. If your child develops symptoms after 48 hours and then receives a positive test, parents should follow the contact tracing instructions provided by NHS Test and Trace. I will check for messages on a daily basis, with my final check taking place at 3.30pm on Christmas Eve.

Finally, thank you all very much for your support this term. I really appreciate it and I wish you and your families a very happy, and safe, Christmas.

I look forward to welcoming the children back to school on Tuesday, 5th January 2021.
