Childcare Chargeable Extras

All three and four-year-olds are entitled to free high-quality early education, starting in the term after a child's third birthday until compulsory school age.

The current free entitlement is 15 hours a week (570 hours a year) for 38 weeks of the year.

Eligible families will be able to claim an additional 15 hours free childcare per week, taking their entitlement to 30 hours free childcare a week for 38 weeks of the year (1140 hours a year).

Parents/carers of two-year-olds who meet a range of criteria are entitled to the same amount of free high-quality early years education or childcare, from the term after a child's second birthday until the end of the term in which they are three.

15-hour provision

At Broomhill Primary School, we offer this from 8:45am to 11:45am, Monday to Friday (3 hours per morning, 5 days per week, term-time only).

30-hour provision

At Broomhill, we offer 30-hour provision from 8:45am to 2:45pm, Monday to Friday (6 hours per day, 5 days a week, term time only).

Additional Offer

Depending on the number of children accessing our nursery provision, there may be the possibility for parents and carers to purchase nursery sessions outside of the government funded hours.

For example...

- If your child has a 15-hour morning place with us, you may be able to purchase additional afternoon sessions.
- If your child has a 30-hour place with us and you would like to extend the day from 2:45pm to 3:15pm, you can pay to extend this session. This may be useful for parents who have older children in school.
- If your child has turned three and is yet to receive the government funding that comes the term after their third birthday, you may be able to purchase morning sessions or full day sessions.

We also offer breakfast club and afterschool club sessions, subject to availability.

- Breakfast Club 8am to 8.45am – available Monday to Friday
- After School Club 3.15pm to 4.15pm – available Monday to Thursday
- After School Club 3.15pm to 5.15pm – available Tuesday to Thursday
